Making Prayer Meetings Christ-Centered

2. Think of your contacts: friends, family and church groups. Then call, text, or use your favorite social media app to message them!


3. Ask Jesus who to invite and how to invite them.


Challenge yourself to invite five new people every week.

How do we engage our participants in worship?


Draw our gaze towards God by...

- 1. Using a video worship song with lyrics
- Using live worship with a single instrumentalist or group
- ω Using responsive reading of scriptures, devotional readings, poetry, lectio divina, etc.
- 4. Individual or group acapella singing
- Incorporate prayer on top of instrumental worship music
- л С Share communion together as an element of worship
- Any other direction God gives you that creatively draws our eyes towards Him
- Other forms of worship such as dance, movement, mime, banners, sign language, natural scenic videos, etc.






